





In 1960, André took over his parents' farm on the Ardèche plateau. He is one of the first to plant syrah between the hill of the Hermitage and the vertiginous slopes of Cornas. The domain is quite fragmented and extends over various complementary terroirs.

- GRAPE VARIETIES
- Syrah
- TERROIR AND VINES
- Produced on steep, south-facing slopes. The vines are protected from cold winds by a natural amphitheater.
- VINIFICATION AND AGEING
- Traditional vinification, vatting for 15 to 20 days. Aging in casks for 18 months.
- TASTING COMMENTS
- This is a rich wine with a dark, almost black colour. It has a long ageing potential, with aromas of black fruit and pepper of medium intensity. Powerful on the palate with a strong structure, very persistent.
- FOOD/WINE PAIRING
- Enjoy with strong dishes such as red meats or game returning from hunting.
- CELLARING POTENTIAL
- Up to 20 years old.
