





In 1960, André took over his parents' farm on the Ardèche plateau. He is one of the first to plant syrah between the hill of the Hermitage and the vertiginous slopes of Cornas. The domain is quite fragmented and extends over various complementary terroirs.

- GRAPE VARIETIES
- Syrah
- TERROIR AND VINES
- Produced on the left bank of the Rhône, at the 45th parallel, the plots are located on the Terrasses of the Hauts Châssis formed of rolled pebbles and red clay.
- VINIFICATION AND AGEING
- Traditional vinification, two-week vatting period. Partly aged in oak barrels for 6 months.
- TASTING COMMENTS
- Tender and delicious, this wine has a garnet-red colour and a nose of red fruit and floral aromas.
- FOOD/WINE PAIRING
- Best served with confit lamb shoulder, herb puree or cassoulet-style coconut stew.
- CELLARING POTENTIAL
- Up to 5 years old.
